Rather than feel exhausted, I hope we sense that there is nowhere where Jesus is not. He is present ahead of us and in each moment, as the Psalmist wrote - there is nowhere to go out of God's presence even if we try to. This should be reassuring and exciting. A mystic like Hildegard of Bingen would see this as meaning that the whole of creation is throbbing with the presence of God, especially as we feel more warmth in the sun and the sap already beginning to rise. I've heard my first lark soaring, pouring forth song, and felt joy well up inside in response. May we notice God's presence around us and share the joy. *Jane*
