We hit the headlines with our advertising for a Team Vicar by being spotlighted in this week's Roots & Shoots Diocesan mailing. The Communications team had chosen a pretty picture of a lighthouse with drift of mauve thrift in the foreground and a sweeping blue sky beyond. Only, as Madeline pointed out, it was Trevoze Lighthouse in North Cornwall which she knows well from regular holidays in that area. I've suggested this feature is repeated only with a local lighthouse and then realised I don't have a snap of Hartland lighthouse, but someone might. It was Richard (Breese, Church Warden for St. Helens, Lundy) who pointed out the Mission Community actually have four lighthouses – and three of them are on Lundy! I wonder if 4 is a Mission Community record? A lighthouse warns of danger, is built strong to withstand the stormy winds and waves and becomes a landmark itself. In our Lenten journey may we become aware of dangers to our faith - sloughs of despondency, self pity or fears - imagined or real. Become stronger through time spent exploring these with God and risking sharing with other Christians for perspective and prayer. As we look back, may we see some markers along the way where we have grown, changed direction and gained new realisation. Don't forget to pray that someone will be signposted to our vacancy! *Jane*
