### **Rev. Jane Skinner - Team Rector**

Previously ministering in the Golden Cap Team, a group of 12 churches in Salisbury Diocese, Jane has experience as Vicar and Chaplain in four Diocese since 1984. Originally ordained into the Lay Order of Deaconess, Jane has been amongst the first women to be ordained as Deacon and then Priest. Married to Stephen, a fellow ordinand of Cranmer Hall, Durham. Chaplaincy has been in prison (Haverigg, Cumbria) and hospital ministry (Carlisle and Swindon).
